What is it about this cause that tugs at our heart strings despite the smiling faces and absence of visible symptoms? In fact, it's exactly that which contributes to misunderstanding about type 1 diabetes, too often confused with the adult form of the disease (type 2 diabetes).



For example, you might be surprised to know that...

- ~ a growing percentage of children are being diagnosed in early childhood, particularly under the age of 5;
- ~ type 1 diabetes is not at all caused by eating habits, desserts or sweets;
- ~ a person with type 1 diabetes is dependent upon multiple daily injections of insulin for his or her survival;
- ~ on a daily basis, our diabetic children experience drops and rises in blood sugar levels, which can lead to a serious condition;
- ~ children and adolescents need to test their blood sugar levels 4 to 7 times a day in order to monitor and adjust their treatment;
- ~ frequent, severe swings in blood sugar levels can result in cognitive impairments or even death;
- ~ type 1 diabetes represents 5% to 10% of all cases of diabetes;
- ~ the incidence of type 1 diabetes is on the rise worldwide;
- ~ to date, there is no available cure;
